Agenda was approved and the old minutes were approved.

1. Old Business

a. Gordy Ringberg sent a letter back to PBSD rejecting the payment offer from February. It asked for a new negotiation meeting. No response from PBSD.

2. Public works director report

a. There was a break in at the lift station building. Two compressors and a roto rooter device were stolen. The insurance company has been contacted and is sending out an adjuster.

3. Utility operator report

- a. Mike reported that Sarah was interviewed by Public Radio about the Bayfield's efforts to reduce water utility emissions.
- b. There are still 30 water meters that need to be replaced with the new wireless systems.
- c. Prices for the reed bed replacement are coming in higher than budgeted.
- d. A new Safe Water Funding request has been submitted.
- 4. Road restrictions have been put into effect today, 03/12. Bayfield followed the county announcement.
- 5. Task order documents were submitted by Strand Engineering for future projects at an estimated cost or \$20,000 for the next 3 years. PWC approved to be forwarded to city council for approval.
- 6. Dumpster day is scheduled for May 12th, 2018, with the city clean up week being the week before.
- 7. Next PWC meeting is scheduled for 04/13/18 at the fire hall at 9AM.
