1. Old Business

- a. No action from Pike's Bay Sanitary District
- b. Swede Hill project still needs Hwy 13 road patch. The retainer is still on hold till that is complete.

2. Public works director report

- a. Tom reported that we had unused funds in the capitol equipment budget. Motion was made and passed to transfer to the small equipment fund.
- b. Tom is preparing the bidding process to get the Chip Sealing going this summer. He will prepare a list of primary and secondary needs.

3. Utility operator report

- a. Mike reported that the current bill for 124 No 2nd St has been paid. There still is a significant balance on the account that if not paid will go to the county. Service was not shut off.
- b. Hydrant flushing starts next week throughout the city.
- c. The DNR will be here later this month to do the sanitary survey.
- d. The Quilt shop issue with a possible water leak inside the premises is still not resolved due to lack of access.
- 4. The Marina put in a request for a lower rate to keep the price down to encourage boaters from waste dumping. Discussion came up with a compromise price of \$5.00 per pump out. Motion passed.
- 5. Discussion was had on sewage dump rates for the Cruise Service, currently at \$643 for the season. Originally that price was for 1 vessel. There are now 4 vessels. Committee came up with \$675 per vessel for this season. Motion passed.
- 6. Financials were reviewed, no action.
