Motion to approve agenda was approved

Motion to approve Minutes from April meeting, approved

1. Review Financials
 - a. Brief review of PSC report. One larger item was water loss. There is still a leak on Manypenny and 2nd. Motion to accept and place on file, passed.
2. Old Business
 - a. There was discussion on the Hwy 13 sink hole. The county did do a temporary fix, but there is more to do. A meeting is scheduled on May 26th to discuss responsibilities between the state, county, and the city. Direction was given to Tom K to not accept responsibility for the city as there is established precedent on similar issues on 13 in the city limits that were covered by the state.
3. Public Works Report
 - a. Dumpster day was a success with typical usage.
 - b. The new backhoe will arrive in late July. Motion was made and passed to finance with a 5 year note.
 - c. The chip seal project is scheduled for late summer.
4. Utility Operator Report
 - a. PFA's water testing should happen in August.
 - b. The flushing of water hydrants will continue this week.
 - c. What appears to be a water leak on Hwy13 is not. The water coming up is ground water.
5. Farmers Market
 - a. The permit application for the Farmers Market was reviewed. Motion to approve permit was approved.
6. PWD job description
 - a. The current job description was reviewed. Recommendations were given by PWC and Jim Bryan will make adjustments for final review in the next meeting.
