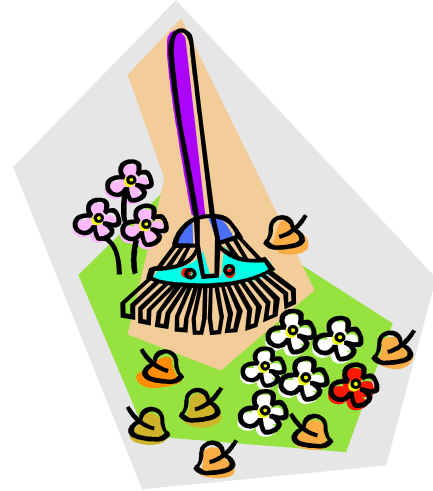
#### Materials that will be picked up and disposed of by the City

- Leaves/Garden Waste/Brush/Tree Limbs.
- Leaves & garden waste must be disposed of in biodegradable 2-3 ply 30 gallon brown kraft paper bag(s).
- These bags are available locally.

#### Rules:

1. Material must be placed at curbside or within 10 ft. of alleyway.
2. Each homeowner may set out for collection, 2 cu. yards or 1 dump truck load of leaves, brush, limbs or garden waste.
3. Additional waste can be set out for collection by making arrangements ahead of time at City Hall. The charge will be \$50.00 per 2 cu. yards or 1 dump truck load.
4. The City will furnish bags to schools and organizations who volunteer their services during cleanup week.

**Where:** Parking lots located at Broad Street and Washington Ave.

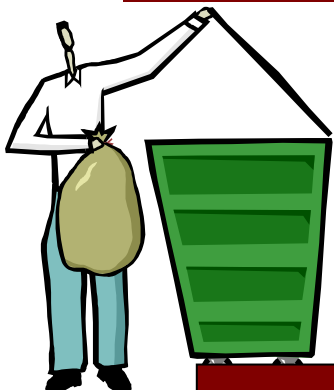
**Rules:** The City will provide dumpsters for the placement of:
