BRB Recycling is a cooperative: Serving recycling for the three communities of the City of Bayfield, Town of Bayfield, and the Town of Russell. Decisions are made by a six person board with two persons appointed from each municipality.

How are Household Recycling Expenses Paid?

Three ways: Your household membership fee, a DNR grant for household recycling and contributions from the Town of Russell, Town of Bayfield and City of Bayfield.

How are Business Recycling Expenses Paid?

Because we have no funding for businesses recycling or households outside of the member municipalities, you are welcome at our site but must pay the full expenses for recycling as well as to use a separate recycling bin. Businesses are \$60 member fee (\$20 household membership not included) plus a per item charge. Households outside of the member municipality pay one \$60/annual fee.
