1. Resolution #612: Library Levy Exemption

Dougherty/Bland moved to approve Resolution #612 requesting exemption from the Bayfield County Library Levy. Passed by roll call vote as follows: Bland, Carrier, Cornelius, and Dougherty – yes.

2. Resolution #613: 2024 Budget & Capital Improvement Projects

The Mayor and Clerk Hoopman provided an overview of the 2024 budget presented. Discussion ensued on the use of fund balances, Capital Improvement projects and borrowing. Hoopman provided a breakdown of the City's Cash and Savings balances for reference and noted we are using \$285,000 of the surplus funds to balance the budget. We used \$195,500 last year.

Discussion continued.

- How/when and on what should the City spend the remaining capital expenditure fund balance on?
- The City must find new revenue sources. Seeking state assistance and higher premier resort tax, continue investigating paid parking, putting debt on the levy, and going to referendum to increase the levy were all mentioned.
- It was also decided a Finance Committee would be re-established.

Dougherty/Carrier moved to accept the 2024 Budget as presented in order to move forward with the required public hearing which will be held on Wednesday, November 15, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. Carried; all ayes.

3. Resolution # 614: 2024 Wages: Dougherty/Bland made a motion to approve the 2024 Wage Resolution as presented. Brief discussion ensued on the 2023 and 2024 percent increase. Passed by roll call vote as follows: Carrier, Cornelius, Dougherty, and Bland – yes.
