Public Input on Agenda Items: None.

Agenda Item(s):

1. Clipper Brewing LLC – Sign Permit Request (Multi-Business Premise)

Bland/Johnson moved to approve the sign permit request from Clipper Brewing allowing them to put up one 4' round sign left of their entry door (second level, north side of building) and a 3' round secondary sign on the railing facing Wilson Avenue. Carried.

- 2. Conditional Use Permit 21 South 3rd Street: Revised Parking Plan Johnson/Carrier moved to approve the revised parking plan as presented from Travis Patterson, 21 South 3rd Street; guests to park in front space off 3rd Street, owner to use old driveway to access garage spaces in the rear of property. Carried.
- 3. City of Bayfield Wayfinding Project: 90% Design Development Package II May 2023

A. Vehicular Directional Signs:

- All Increase space between listings so sign is easier to read.
- All Center Bayfield Logo on all signs. Bayfield should be centered on the top of sign, both vertically and horizontally.
- All Ask if border can be added that matches the border shown on the Restroom Signs (90% Design – Pg. Facility ID Restrooms 1.3). It was felt this was asked before and the DOT rules don't allow it; please double check.
- 1 3.1 move closer to intersection and make sign two-sided. Sign text:
 - → Boat Launch Information

Rec Center - ask the Rec Center if they would be wiling to remove directional sign all together, if yes, remove listing.

- Remove Restrooms
- 2 3.1 Eliminate

- 3 3.1 Make it two sided. Change text to:
 - → Boat Launch Restrooms
 - ↑ Information (West Side Only)
 - Remove Trailer Parking
- 4a./4b. 3. 1 Ok as shown.
- 5 3.1 Change National to Nat'l
- 6 3.1 Remove Restrooms
- B. <u>Metal Finishes:</u> The Commission would have preferred metal samples, but by consensus agreed to use a black finish, so all wayfinding signs match.
- C. Review Homework Assignment: Where are icon signs needed and what content
 A variety of thoughts and opinions were shared on what icons to place and where. For a
 variety of reasons including fairness and sign clutter, the Commission agreed to get icon
 sign schematic/designs so that if needed at a later date, they could easily be purchased and
 installed.
