1. Review Financials
 - a. No issues found
2. Old Business
 - a. Tom got a cost estimate from the engineers for the west end of Manypenny Ave that has been requested. The estimate was \$489,000 for the work and \$40,000 for the engineering. Estimate will be placed on file.
3. Public works Director
 - a. Tom reported that the white truck work is about ½ done, should get it by the end of the month. He still needs to look into the hail damage.
 - b. Quote for road salt came in at \$71.10 per ton, down from last year.
 - c. The chip sealing project has been delayed until next spring.
4. Utility Operator Report
 - a. Mike reported that he and Tom had attended the Water and waste water conference and found it educational.
 - b. Mike reported that there is a DNR water system inspection coming up.
 - c. The well #4 roof project is delayed by the contractor due to supply issues.
 - d. Mike reported that they will be fixing the approach on well #3.
 - e. Mike reported that the lift station is in need of repair, efficiency is down.

 - a. Tom provided with the road rating spreadsheet from Pacerware so that we could see the condition of the streets in the city.
