Meeting called to order by Bryan at 9AM. Present: Brevold, Whiteside, Kelly, Bryan, Peterson: City employees; Kovachevich, Burg, Mather. David Eades was present from the Chamber.

Agenda was approved and the old minutes were approved.

#### 1. Old Business

- a. There has not been any reply from the PBSD in regard to the letter sent from Gordy Ringberg.
- b. Swede Hill pay request #3 has been processed.

## 2. Public works director report

- a. The new frontend loader has been delivered and is now in the garage ready for use.
- b. May 6<sup>th</sup> through the 11<sup>th</sup> is city clean up week. Dumpster day is the 12<sup>th</sup>.
- c. Tom K reported that the wireless meter reader is no longer supported, may need replacement in the future.
- d. Insurance covered all but the \$1000 deductible for the equipment that was stolen earlier this year. The replacement roto rooter has not yet been delivered.
- e. City insurance will cover a portion of the damage to the pavilion and deck from last year's storm.
- f. The turning point project has started and soil issues have become an issue. Engineers will review issue on Monday the 16<sup>th</sup>.
- g. The fire Department open house will be on June 16<sup>th</sup>.
- h. PW is planning on doing ditch cleaning this summer with rented equipment.
- i. Tom K is working on bids to do seal coating on 4 blocks of our newer streets.

### 3. Utility operator report

- a. Mike has started turning on water service to summer only residents
- b. The DNR has a new rep that Mike will work with for the sanitary survey.
- c. The Quilt Shop may have had a water break, but Mike has not been able to gain access to inspect. Water has been turned off for now.
- d. A second break in attempt happened at the old sewer plant, the individuals did not gain access. A suspect has been arrested.
- e. There was a discussion about the pump out rate for AIM, will put on next month's agenda.
- 4. David Eades from the chamber had made a request for parking restrictions during the Art Fest. This issue has a standing order and did not need to be addressed.
- 5. 124 N 2<sup>nd</sup> St has not paid their water/sewer bill for over a year. A motion was made and passed to support PW to disconnect the service sometime after the 15<sup>th</sup>.
