1. Old Business:

3. Project updates:
 - a Well #4 – Natural gas piped in, need to make connection for generator
 - b Iron Bridge Light Poles – A quote was received of \$14,576. Decided to order 2 to fit in budget and plan for other 2 lights in next budget.
 - c Xcel – 4” gas main will not be installed this year
4. Items listed for sale on Wisconsin Surplus: 3 items listed now, 3 more to be listed
5. Freight elevator decommission at courthouse – Is due for inspection (at a cost). No one is using it. The plan is to decommission it. Currently looking for quotes
6. Vacant Lots, utilities and infrastructure discussion – no discussion this meeting.
7. Utility Operators Report
 - a Lift station – fiber is going in, goal is to reduce communications failures
 - b Painting well exterior in Mid-August
