A resolution recommending the adoption of an Update to the 2001-2021 City of Bayfield Comprehensive Plan

Whereas, the City of Bayfield Plan Commission met over the course of two years to comply with the state's Smart Growth Law requiring that comprehensive plans be reviewed and updated every ten years;

Whereas, the Plan Commission, recognized that the current 2001-2021 Comprehensive Plan is still valid in many respects, and contains valuable background information – historical, cultural and geographical, etc. – that remains highly relevant and should be considered as an additional resource;


Whereas, the Plan Commission, under the direction of consultant, Nan Fey, devised a plan to update the Comprehensive Plan by incorporating ideas from more recent plans, and highlighting issues like senior housing, health equity and climate change; and

Whereas, the City of Bayfield has held open meetings and provided minutes and notes on the public record, mailed a progress report to resident's mid-way through the process, provided periodic updates on quarterly utility bills and the city's website, and hosted a day-long community gathering that was very well attended; now, therefore, be it






