Refine & standardize questions for forthcoming committee reviews:

- First Pass (for committees that have many tasks to review)
  - Completed? Can answer Yes and “still need to talk about it”
  - If “still need to talk about it” consider setting a timeframe
    - Now?
    - As needed?
    - Within 5 years?
- Further Questions (if time, or later)
  - Relevance?
  - Priority?
  - What more do we need to know?

Issues to keep in mind at the planning stage

- Distinguishing between policy and regulation
- Review schedules for Actions developed in the Update
  - One and done? Medium term? Aspirational “Pie in the Sky”?

Guiding Principles identified

- Happy and healthy children (and good programs for them)
- Preserve open space, waterfront, views
- Utilize local resources e.g. DNR, NRCS, USFS, land conservation strategies
- Encourage year-round businesses (133)
- Do not sacrifice scale & small-town atmosphere (140)
- Preserve & protect the continuation of historic businesses (150)
- Encourage infill and redevelopment downtown (134, 339)
- Green development guidelines? (108/9)
